

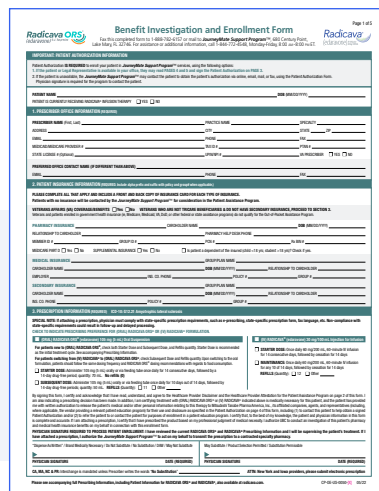
Starting Your Treatment With RADICAVA ORS® (edaravone)

Complete a Benefit Investigation and Enrollment Form, or BIF, with your doctor.

Once you and your doctor have decided RADICAVA ORS® is the appropriate treatment, completing a BIF begins the benefit investigation process to see if you have health plan coverage for your medication. If you are currently receiving treatment with RADICAVA® (edaravone) IV, completing a BIF with your doctor is the best way to get started with RADICAVA ORS®. Having your information ready may help streamline the process of filling your prescription.

Step 1: Download a BIF from RadicavaORS.com.

You can use the fillable form to enter your information. If you prefer, you can print it and fill it out by hand. Completing a BIF with your information is NOT a commitment to starting treatment.



- Enter your health insurance information on page 1
 - Complete and sign on page 3 to participate in the **JourneyMate Support Program™** after reading the Patient Authorization on page 4
- Please do NOT send the form yourself.

Step 2: Take the BIF to your doctor.

When you and your doctor decide RADICAVA ORS® may be right for you, your doctor will complete the rest of the BIF (**Sections 1 and 3**), which will act as the prescription, and submit as early as possible.

If you're unable to provide your signature on the form—for whatever reason—a **JourneyMate Support Program™** Insurance & Access Specialist will contact you to obtain your authorization.
